

MINERS ENTOMBED BY EXPLOSION OF POWDER

CHARLESTOWN, Va., April 21.—A mine explosion in the Cabin Creek Mining Company's mine near Kayford, about thirty miles above here, late yesterday afternoon, may result in the death of five miners and the fatal injury of three others.

The disaster is believed to have been caused by a powder explosion, the result of a miner's carelessness. Those who were buried in the mine were: Burt Green, Ira Nichols, Charles Nicholas, Arthur Crump, William Allen.
