

SIX MEN SAID TO BE IMPRISONED

**Fire in Clyde Mine at Fredericktown,
Where Explosion Occurred, Still
Raging.**

Brownsville, Pa., Oct. 14.—The fire in Clyde mine at Fredericktown, where an explosion occurred late yesterday, is still burning, and six men are said to be imprisoned. Whether dead or alive is not known. They are George Kelly, Homer Harvey, Henry Smith and three foreigners. Rescue parties are working in shifts, but as the smoke is dense, despite the work of the fans the labor is slow. The entombed men are about 1,500 feet from the pit mouth. All efforts now are being made toward shutting off the burning portion to stop the progress of the flames and provide a way around to reach the men.
