

IMPRISONED MINER RESCUED

Italian Entombed by Cave-in Is Taken Out Unhurt.

(Special Dispatch.)

WALLACE, Dec. 13.—James Cozzaglio, the Italian miner imprisoned by a cave-in in the Springville prospect last evening, was rescued by a crew of men from Wallace and Mullan at 4:30 this morning. He was unhurt.

The tunnel in which the miner was working is about 55 feet long and the first cave took place about half way between the tunnel's face and its mouth. Cozzaglio was working in the extreme face when the accident happened. Several caves occurred following the first and when the man was rescued by the crews, working since 3:30 last night he was confined in a space about four feet in width.
