

BLAME PLACED

Cause of Princeton Mine Disaster Laid at Door of Two Employees.

ONE OF THEM IS DEAD

The Other Will be Prosecuted
--Inspector Forwarded Report Today.

Indianapolis, Ind., March 27.— State Mine Inspector Epperson forwarded the report of the coroner of Gibson county on the Princeton mine disaster today. It says there was a gross violation of the law on the part of Harry Targett, who was killed by the shot he fired, and on the part of Roscoe Hedrick, who prepared the shot for firing. Hedrick was not killed. According to Epperson, he will be indicted by the grand jury.
