

LAST VICTIM RECOVERED FROM DUTCHMAN MINE

After a week of unremitting effort on the part of the company's officials and the men under them, the last body of the men who were killed by an explosion in the Dutchman mine at Blossburg early in the morning of October 6 was taken out Thursday, the 11th. On account of the conditions prevailing in the mine since the explosion the work of searching for the bodies has been very laborious and also dangerous. But night and day the work was heroically prosecuted until the tenth and the last body, that of John Berry, was recovered.

The funeral over the remains of Berry was held at 11 o'clock Friday morning in the Catholic church and the remains were laid to rest in the Mount Calvary cemetery.—Raton Reporter.
