

MINER'S NARROW ESCAPE.

Buried for Hours Under Tons of Quicksand.

Virginia, Minn., Jan. 27.—Buried under 20 feet of quicksand for nearly 10 hours and rescued alive was the experience of Victor Peltoniemi, a workman at the Lincoln mine near here.

Peltoniemi owes his life to a large boulder weighing several tons, which fell in such a way as to rest on some mining timbers and form a small cavity about his chest and head, the other parts of his body being held by the dirt as tightly as if gripped in a vice.
