VERDICT OF CORONER'S JURY ON DARR MINE EXPLOSION

GREENSBURG, Pa., Jan. 21.—The verdict of the coroner's jury which investigated the Darr mine explosion was returned tonight exonerating the Pittsburg Coal Company and attributing the explosion to the use of an open lamp.

The verdict declares the disaster was caused by the accidental explosion of gas ignited by an open lamp at an initial point which we were unable to decide, owing to difference of opinion between inspectors and experts, which explosion was augmented by coal dust that extended throughout the mine."
