

## TWENTY MINERS KILLED.

Explosion at Thomas, W. Va.—Fourteen  
Bodies Are Taken Out.

CUMBERLAND, Md., Feb. 5.—At least twenty men were killed yesterday in an explosion in Mine No. 25 of the Davis Coal and Coke company at Thomas, W. Va. Late last evening the bodies of fourteen men had been taken out.

Capt. D. R. Jones lost his life at the head of a rescuing party. He was overcome by after damp, a deadly gas that follows an explosion of fire damp. All the dead are Italians and Lithunians.
