

THIRTY MINERS ARE ENTOMBED

An Explosion in a Mine at
Haileyville, Oklahoma,
Early Today

BARREL OF OIL
CAUSES BLAZE

Mine is Burning Fiercely
and There's No Chance
for Miners

McAllister, Okla., Aug. 26—A mine explosion occurred in coal mine No. 1 at Haileyville, Oklahoma, near here, this afternoon. Thirty miners are said to have been entombed.

Kansas City, Mo., Aug. 26—A telephone message from McAllister this afternoon confirmed the first report of the mine disaster at Haileyville and it is stated there is no hope of rescuing the twenty-five or thirty miners who are entombed. All of the men are foreigners. The mine, which is one of the largest in the southwest, is burning fiercely, the result of a barrel of oil catching fire. It appears there was no explosion.
