

TWO MORE DEATHS IN FATAL ZEIGLER MINE

**Miners Were Looking For Bodies When
Explosion Occurred.**

BENTON, ILL., Feb. 9.—An explosion, the second within the past five weeks, occurred in the mine of the Zeigler Coal company at Zeigler in this county today. Two men were killed and a third mortally injured.

In the explosion in the mine early in January 26 were killed. The bodies of 19 were removed, but before the remaining seven could be found the mine was closed and kept in that condition until last week, when men were started to work cleaning the underground workings and searching for the bodies.

Its origin is not known, but it is thought to have been caused by one of the miners igniting the fire damp with his lamp.
