

**MINE DISASTER  
CLAIMS ANOTHER**

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**Five Dead Now as Result  
of Gas Explosion.**

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**IN THE FATED NO. 14 SHAFT**

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**JOHN REMBOICH LAST TO AN-  
SWER SUMMONS—THOS. FLEM-  
ING DIED YESTERDAY.**

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The death list is growing in the big disaster at No. 14 shaft of the Pennsylvania Coal Co. Yesterday John Remboich died at the Pittston hospital. That increases the number to five. It is feared that two others, Bernard Coyle and Anthony Cardo, will die.

Thomas Fleming died at the Pittston hospital early yesterday morning. He was 23 years of age and a son of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Fleming, of Browntown. He was a well known amateur ball player and very popular. The surviving members of the family are his parents and the following brothers and sisters: Martin and James Fleming, Mrs. Owen Gavin and Alice and Nellie Fleming. The funeral will be held to-morrow morning. Interment will be made in St. John's cemetery.
