

BURIED MINERS SAVED

Forty Men Work Forty-seven Hours and Rescue Two Workmen.

Reno, Nev., Nov. 9.—Charles Moody and Harry Anderson the Carlin, Nev., miners who were buried under tons of rock and timbers in a cave-in in the Copper King mine Friday were rescued alive at 1 o'clock this afternoon.

Falling rock warned the men that something was wrong and gave them time to crawl up to the 170-foot level They had barely reached safety when the cave-in occurred.

Forty men worked forty-seven hours to rescue the buried miners.
