December 31, 1910.—P. W. Tramel, Fireman, 48, American, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house killing him instantly.

December 31, 1910.—Patsey Marino, Miner, 40, Italian, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house, killing him instantly.

December 31, 1910.—Salvation Beelena, Miner, 40, Italian, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house, killing him instantly.

December 31, 1910.—Frank Pondiana, Miner, 35, Italian, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house, so that he died the next day.

December 31, 1910.—Savias Digugerios, Miner, 38, Italian, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house fatally injuring him, so that he died next day.

December 31, 1910.—Mike Billy, Miner, 35, Italian, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house, fatally injuring him, so that he died next day.

December 31, 1910.—Joe Beelen, Miner, 25, Italian, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house, killing him instantly.

December 31, 1910.—Mike Marino, Miner, 20, Italian, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house, house, killing him instantly.

December 31, 1910.—Patsey Monchella, Miner, 33, Italian, Lick Fork Mine. This man was riding on incline and cars ran away, crushing through drum house, killing him instantly.

February 2, 1911.—Frank Orris, Miner, 41, Hungarian, Red Jacket Mine. Instantly killed by fall of slate.

May 15, 1911.—Steve Sczijarto, Assistant Foreman, 43, Hungarian, Williamson No. 3 Mine. He disregarded warning not to go under piece of slate, that had been loosened by a shot, and was instantly killed by its fall.
