

## INJURED BY FALL DOWN MINE SHAFT

Falling a considerable distance down a manway at the Gardner shaft, A. D. Creamer, a miner, was rendered unconscious about 8 o'clock last night and for a time it was feared he was seriously injured.

He was removed to the surface and conveyed in an ambulance to the Copper Queen hospital. He recovered consciousness there, however, and an examination by Dr. Bridge showed that no bones were broken. He is still suffering from the shock, and will probably remain at the hospital a day or two. His bodily injuries amounted to only a few scratches.

At about the same time as the accident at the Gardner, Peter Hirgo, at the Lowell shaft, was overcome by gases in the mine and was rendered unconscious. He was also revived at the hospital and went home later.
