FIFTEEN DEATHS DUE TO CARELESSNESS

Inspector Reports on Cause of Explosion in Mine at Amsterdam, O.

collimbus, o., May 13.—Defective ventilation, the result of carelessness, caused the explosion in the mine of the Youghiogheny & Ohio Coal company at Amsterdam, Jefferson county, the night of April 21, resulting in the death of fifteen miners. This is the finding of Chief Mine Inspector George Harrison, after thorough investigation, in his report just submitted to Governor Harmon.
