
JOY KILLED HIM

Miner Rescued After Long Entombment Overcome By Emotion.

Pottsville, Pa., April 30.—After being imprisoned for 18 hours by a fall of coal at the Packer No. 5 Lehigh Valley colliery, near Girardville, Robert Metukas was rescued at one o'clock this morning, uninjured, but died an hour later from excess of joy on being taken from the tomb. A large force of men worked in relays all day yesterday and last night spurred on by the rappings heard from within.
