FIVE KILLED IN MINE FIRE.

Miners Overcome by Smoke in Blaze at Boston Colliery.

WILKESBARRE, Pa., May 11.-Bodies of five men were taken from the Boston of the Delaware and Hudson Company at Larksville, near here today, following a severe fire Wednesday The men were overcome by smoke. who had been rendered conscious by smoke were saved from the government rescue corps. The fire is believed to have been started by open lamp left in the shaft by a worklamp fired timbers and blaze spread rapidly. A strike began at the colliery Tuesday, when few men were work. But for that the loss would have been fearful.
