

ONE DEAD, FOUR INJURED IN AN EXPLOSION IN MINE

SHAMOKIN, Pa., May 27.—In an explosion of gas in the Mineral Railroad and Mining Company's Cameron Colliery today, four rockmen were seriously injured and John Moore, fire boss, was burned and bruised to such an extent that he died at Miners' Hospital shortly after the accident. The dead and injured:

John Moore, fire boss, burned and bruised about face, head and body.

John Jock, chargeman, burned about face, hands and body and injured internally. Injuries will likely prove fatal.

John Schemulski, machine runner, burned internally and about body. May recover.

John Starick, machine runner, burned about face and body, may recover.

John Rubolish, helper, seriously burned and bruised. May recover.
