

FOUR MEN DIE WHEN WIRE CABLE SNAPS

Loaded Cars Run Away at
Marvine Colliery Near
Scranton, Pa.

Scranton, Pa., Sept. 13.—Through the breaking of a wire cable four loaded cars ran away at the Marvine colliery here late yesterday and killed four men.

The cable parted as the cars were emerging from the mouth of the mine and they traveled half a mile down a 45 degree slope before they dashed into the miners.
