

ELEVEN MEN BURIED UNDER A SNOWSLIDE

**Copper Mountain Avalanche Carries
Away Great Northern Develop-
ment Company Buildings.**

Cordova, Alaska, Dec. 9.—Nine men are believed to have been killed when a snowslide of Copper mountain carried away seven buildings of the Great Northern Development company. Eleven men were buried under the avalanche and only two have been removed alive. Three are known to be dead, and no hope is entertained for six others.

The bodies of John Hart, James McGavock and Frank Wahls have been recovered.
