

FIVE MEN BURNED IN GAS EXPLOSION AT THE MOCANACQUA COLLIERY

Five employees were seriously burned by an explosion of gas at the Mocanacqua colliery this morning. Details of the accident are meagre, and repeated telephone calls to the company's office fail to elicit the character or identity of the men's injuries. The men were removed from the colliery in ambulances and it is

said two of them are on their way to the Nanticoke Hospital.

The victims are company hands.

Two victims reached the City Hospital this afternoon, Walter Dooznski, aged 27, of Moconocqua, and William Blakeslee, of Shickshinny. The company did not announce the names of the others.
