Tamaqua, Pa., April 3.—After having been imprisoned for thirty-six hours by a fall of coal at No. 8 colliery, John Rubicar, a laborer, was rescued and is practically uninjured. Evan Tonkin, imprisoned at the same time, but rescued shortly after, was fatally injured.
