

FLAW IN METAL CAUSED ACCIDENT THAT KILLED NINE

CLIFTON, Ariz., Aug. 14.—A broken drawhead in one of the two ore cars which yesterday tumbled 13 men down an incline near Metcalf, Ariz., was blamed for the loss of nine lives by a coroner's jury that convened late today. The metal showed a flaw where it had parted.

The coroner's list of the killed includes William Anthony Schaefer of New York city, a mining engineer. The other employees of the Coronado mine who were killed were Arizona residents.
