Shenandoah, Pa., Oct. 18. — John Kender, a well known miner, had a narrow escape from death at the Shenandoah colliery, where a heavy fall of coal and rock took place, making him a prisoner. Rescuers, after six hours of hazardous work, finally took Kender from his living prison, painfully but not seriously injured.
