

MINE DISASTER COSTS LIVES OF TWELVE

ALL BUT ONE WHO ENTER EUREKA
MINE FAIL TO COME
OUT ALIVE

SALT LAKE, Utah, Sept. 17.—
Twelve men were hopelessly buried
by a cave-in in the Oklahoma stope
of the Centennial Eureka mine at
Eureka at 3 o'clock this afternoon.
At 8 o'clock tonight the first body
was recovered at the edge of the
stope. There was little dirt on the
body and it is believed the miner
was killed by the concussion follow-
ing the cave-in.

Thirteen entered the stope with
the day shift. John Wick, a Finn,
escaped and he attributes it to the
fact that he is superstitious. He
says he had a "hunch" when the
lights went out. The accident was
between the twelve and sixteen foot
levels. The mine continues to cave
in, hindering the work of the res-
cuers.
