

The Royalton Mine Disaster Is Blamed on One Miner.

ROYALTON, ILL., Nov. 5.—The explosion which caused the death of fifty-two men in the mine of the Franklin County Coal and Coke Company near here several weeks ago was due to the negligence of a miner who crossed the examiner's danger mark and ignited with his lantern the gas in a condemned entry. A report to this effect was made here today by a party of mine experts who have completed an investigation into the causes of the accident.
