

NARROWLY ESCAPED DEATH

Two Marion Lads Caught in Cave-In, Rescued by Companions.

Marion, Ind., July 20.—Paul Williams, eleven year old son of former police judge Marshall Williams, and Claud Collins, aged twelve, narrowly escaped death today when they were caught in a cave-in beneath the Pennsylvania tracks, near the home in West Sixth street. The boys had dug a cave and were inside when a passing train jarred the ground to such an extent that the dirt was loosened until it fell, burying them completely. Several other boys who were near observed the accident and summoned help. In a few minutes the boys were extricated in an unconscious condition.
