

[Associated Press Leased Wire.] JOPLIN, Mo., Jan. 27.— Thomas French, a miner who last night was caught by a cave-in in a zinc mine near here, was rescued early today after having been imprisoned more than eight hours. French was held by a mass of rock and earth with his head free. He directed the work of his rescuers, trying energetically to free himself.

Although seriously injured, French will live, physicians said.

Hope of rescuing Harry Hubbell, French's fellow-workman, was abandoned. He was believed to be buried under fifteen feet of rock.
