

PAINFULLY INJURED IN FALL DOWN MINE SHAFT

John Corbett sustained painful injuries when he fell 75 feet in the shaft at the Anaconda mine early this morning. He was rushed to the St. James hospital where it was found that two ribs had been fractured, one of them puncturing the lung. It is considered probable that Corbett also sustained internal injuries.
