

MINER RESCUED 24 HOURS AFTER BEING ENTOMBED

Accident Causes Man To Be
Buried 1,000 Under Sur-
face.

Shenandoah, Pa., Oct. 14.—Held a prisoner for twenty-four hours in the depths of a mine 1,000 feet below the surface by a fall of rock and coal, Thomas Kilroy, 50, of Ashland, was rescued today.

Suffering severely from exposure, shock and hunger, his condition is critical. However, it is believed that he will recover.

Kilroy was trapped at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon. Rescue crews were immediately organized, and the work of digging through the pile of debris was soon under way. As the men progressed, the fall of the top continued, endangering their own lives.

At 3 o'clock this afternoon they broke through the final barrier.
