More Water Threatens Damage in Amasa Porter Shaft.

Crystal Falls, Mich., Feb. 26. — Revised figures on the loss of life in the Amasa Porter mine accident of Thursday show that sixteen men were killed when a bulkhead gave way, permitting water and quicksand to rush into the mine. As more water is threatening to pour into the mine, it is not known when the bodies will be recovered.
