

**Miner Caught by Cave-in Rescued.**

Victor, Colo.—J. Anderson, a machine drill miner, employed at the Hull City property of the Vindicator mine, was caught by a cave-in of rocks while working at a station on the sixth level. Rescue work was immediately started, and after three hours of labor communication was established with Anderson, who was uninjured save for minor contusions. An air pipe was forced through the debris, and the rescue party got Anderson out.
