MAHANNOY CITY, June 9.—John Wasnoski, fifty, was taken out of an old chamber in the North Mahanoy mine after being entombed for ten hours. He was only slightly injured. Wasnoskie spent most of the hours of his underground imprisonment in prayer. He embraced his rescuers and walked home, refusing to ride in the colliery ambulance.
