

TWENTY MINERS ARE BURIED BY CAVE-IN

RESCUE PARTY WAS FORCED TO
ABANDON EFFORTS WHEN
FIRE BROKE OUT BE-
HIND THEM.

Steubenville, Ohio, Oct. 30.—After battling their way to within 150 feet of 20 miners imprisoned since yesterday morning, rescue workers were ordered out of the mine at Amsterdam by mine officials and state mine inspectors, who feared an explosion might occur, according to word received here. Hope that the miners are still alive has been abandoned. Rescue parties worked all night in the gas-filled mine. Fire broke out behind the rescue party, which forced them to fight their way through smoke and flames, many narrowly escaping suffocation.
