

SIX KILLED AND THREE INJURED

**As Result of Badly Prepared
Shot In Bogle Mine No. 3 at
Jasonville—The Men, Officers
and Office Help Were Trying
to Get Enough Coal to Keep
Up the Steam In the Mine
Boilers.**

Clinton, Ind., Dec. 3.—(Bulletin)—
Six men were killed and three were
seriously injured in an explosion in
the Bogle Mine No. 3, at Jasonville,
near here late this afternoon.

All of the men were either mine of-
ficers or employees in the office of the
company, who in attempting to get
out sufficient coal to keep the boilers
going, set off a badly prepared blast.
The mine has been closed by the
strike.

The men killed by the blast were:
John Stark, of Terre Haute, and Her-
bert Campbell and Joe Robertson, of
Clinton, office men; S. G. Stephens,
of Terre Haute, civil engineer; Charles
Watson, of Clinton, assistant mine
boss, and John Logadan, of Terre
Haute, room boss.

The mine was not badly damaged by
the explosion and but little difficulty
was encountered in removing the in-
jured and the bodies of those who
were killed.
