

## Miner Rescued From Living Tomb

**SHENANDOAH, Pa., March 19.**— Caught beneath a rush of coal when a set of timber became loose, Stiney Narbut, 36 years old, a contract miner employed at Indian Ridge colliery, was buried alive for several hours today. Although seriously injured, he directed the rescue work, but lost consciousness as he was being taken from beneath several tons of coal. He was rushed to the State Hospital at Fountain Springs, where an examination showed that he had sustained internal injuries.
