

BODIES RESCUED

Last Victim of Majestic Mine Taken Out.

Birmingham, Ala., April 30.—With the last black and charred body removed from the shaft of the Majestic Coal mine late last night, the wounded made as comfortable as possible in Birmingham hospitals and mining camp homes, Majestic settled down to rest, after hours of intense suspense and fears.

As the last victim was brought to the top and removed to the emergency dressing station the dead numbered twenty men, two white and eighteen negroes.

The explosion occurred at 11:20 o'clock Tuesday, when someone in the fourth north right entry set off a quantity of gas, causing a gas explosion which wrecked the north side of the mines. At the time of the explosion eleven men were at work in the fourth north right, none of whom escaped.

Every person in the camp came to the shaft. Women and children, grouped around the tippie, waited with grim faces and dry eyes for news from their loved ones.
