

Three Miners Rescued Alive.

Ishpeming, Mich., Dec. 25 — Confined 63 hours in a dark hole about four feet square, hundreds of feet below the ground, three of a quartet of miners in the Cleveland-Cliffs mine near Negaunee were rescued alive. William Medlin was dead. The other three had existed without food or water and were able to climb 400 feet to the shaft. They were in the best of health, apparently, and had planned as a last resort to feed themselves on cedar bark from a timber protruding into their tiny prison.
