

## MINER IS RESCUED

CLINTON, Ind., May 8.—Pinned under three tons of slate, unable to nove anything except his head and one hand, and with heavy pieces of salte falling all around him, Andrew Steen, fire boss at the Deering Coal company mine No. 8 lay for more than five hours, expecting to be killed any moment, before he was found by workmen entering the mine yesterday. The heavy weight on his chest prevented him from calling for help. The chung of slate pinning Steen to the floor was partly supported by the coal wall.
