

Recover Eight Quarry Victims.

Eight bodies have been recovered from the wreckage caused by the premature explosion at the quarry owned by the firm of Boxley and Hunter last Friday morning at Pounding Mill, and it is expected that the ninth one will be dug from the debris within the next week or ten days, according to news received here this morning. The unrecovered body is underneath between seven and eight thousand tons of rock. Rock crushing at the quarry will be started tomorrow. L. J. Boxley, of this city, is still at the scene of the explosion and it is understood that Mayor W. W. Boxley, senior member of the firm of Boxley and Hunter, will return to Pounding Mill tonight.
