

ONE KILLED ONE MISSING

In Mine Explosion at the Submarine Mine Near Terre Haute Today—Seventy-five Imperiled

TERRE HAUTE, May 1—One man was killed and another is missing and believed dead, and five were injured in an explosion at 7:45 this morning in the Submarine mine, owned by Ferguson and Speers, northwest of Terre Haute. The dead are Andrew Wilson, mine boss missing and believed dead, John Howe, track layer of Terre Haute. The injured are Alex Folker, Terre Haute, John Whitmorts, Clinton Samuel Wood, Clinton; Lee Stevens, Clinton, and Robert Montgomery, Clinton. The boy of Howe was still in the mine at 10 o'clock.

Seventy-five men were in the mine at the time and only imperiled a few of the men.
