

MINE CAVE ENGULFS LITTLE BOY AT PLAY

**Child Seriously Hurt—Father Leads
Mob Against Mine Owner**

Scranton, Pa., Aug. 18. (A. P.)—A two-and-a-half years old son of Joseph Bigsigani, of Pittston, was engulfed by a mine cave while playing in the yard at his home today. The child was imprisoned four hours before being rescued and was unconscious when found.

Soon after the child was found, the enraged father led a mob of about two hundred foreigners against the home of John Gibbons, owner of the mine in which the cave occurred, threatening violence. A riot call was sent in and the mob was dispersed by the police. It is not known whether the child will recover.
