

BODIES OF THREE MEN IN MINE ARE RECOVERED OAK CREEK, Colo., Feb. 15.—(A. P.)—The bodies of three of the five men trapped by an explosion in the No. 2 mine of the Moffat Coal Co. Saturday afternoon were recovered Sunday. C. Testas and Henry Wagner, shot firers in the mine, are believed to be dead. Rescuers continued working	last night in an effort to penetrate the wall of earth and coal which cut off their escape. Joe Maryin, superintendent of the Maybro mine, was overcome by mine damp yesterday. He was moved to a hospital in a serious condition. TEACHES 40,000 CLASSES.
