

Eleven Miners Killed in Gas Explosion In Acmar No. 3 Mine in St. Clair County 82 Men Were in Mine at Time of Accident

(Associated Press.)

Birmingham, May 26.—Eleven miners were killed last night in an explosion in Acmar number three mine of the Alabama Fuel & Iron Company, in St. Clair county.

Five of the men are white, according to the first word from the mine.

The accident is attributed to a local gas explosion.

Eighty-two men were at work in the mine and all except those who were trapped in the mine made their escape.

Little damage was done to the mine.
