

MINE EXPLOSION KILLS NINE

Two Hurt Seriously by Blast in Kentucky Coal Shaft—Bodies Recovered.

Williamson, W. Va., Feb. 9.—Nine men were killed and two injured seriously by an explosion in the mine of the Marietta Coal company at Pinsor Fork, Ky., eleven miles from Williamson, it is reported here. The eleven men comprised the day crew of the plant, which was of the slope entry type and a small one. Five of the dead have been identified. All the bodies have been recovered.
