Shenandoah, Sept. 30—Joseph Bartin. savage, a contract miner at Turkey Run Colliery, had a narrow escape from being buried alive when he was closed in behind a heavy fall of coal and rock for almost six hours.

Fellow workmen, at the risk of their lives, owing to the top continually caving in, finally rescued him, only slightly injured.
