

MINE FLOODED MULES RESCUED

At one o'clock on Saturday afternoon a huge volume of water broke thru the Buck Mountain Slope, South Dip, at the Glendower Colliery. The pumps were going frantically on Sat. night and all day Sunday to pump the water out and by Monday morning things were in good shape.

The old workings in various parts of the mines are flooded up to the timber. Two mules were trapped but were rescued by the daring efforts of one of the employees who struggled for two hours in water up to his waist before he could bring the animals out to safety.
