

SAVE BURIED MINER

Pottsville Man Rescued After Hours Under Coal

POTTSVILLE, April 4.—After being buried several hours, Norman Lavenberg, a miner at Eagle Hill colliery, was rescued alive today. Lavenberg was imprisoned when a big mass of coal blocked him off from his fellow miners.

Miners worked frantically to rescue him before he became a victim of mine gas and when rescued he was brought to the Pottsville Hospital without any apparent serious injuries.

He is suffering severely from shock.
