

Boy Rescued From Mine

Pittsburg, Jan. 25.—Tony Bertullo, aged 14, was rescued from an abandoned mine in Mount Washington today after having been imprisoned for twenty hours by a cave-in. The boy was exploring the mine Saturday when a portion of the roof fell, confining him in a space about five feet square. He was rescued by his father and a neighbor after an all night search had led them to the abandoned mine. With the exception of being hungry the boy showed no ill effects of his experience.
