

WOODWARD MINE MISHAP PROBE NOT COMPLETED

Although an investigation has been underway since the time of the explosion on Friday afternoon of last week, company officials have not yet arrived at a definite conclusion as to the cause of the tragedy at the Woodward mine, which cost six persons their lives. Company officials refused to offer any comment today as to the cause of the explosion which snuffed out the lives of six of their workmen.

The investigation was continued today with Mine Inspectors Corgan, D. T. Davis and T. J. Williams joining with the company officials in the underground inspection. Negligence has been mentioned in press reports as the direct cause of the catastrophe and as yet there has been no official denial of this theory.

While the investigators are gathering together the loose ends with which they hope to establish the cause of the explosion, three more of the victims were laid to rest today.
